**Amendment  
to the Examination Regulations  
for the degree course Business Administration with  
Informatics at the South Westphalia University of Applied  
Sciences, Soest campus**

dated 23 January 2020

In accordance with § 2 (4) and § 64 (1) of the Law governing the universities of the federal state of North Rhine-Westphalia (Higher Education Act) of 16 September 2014 (GV.NRW.P.547) – in the version to amend the Higher Education Act dated 12 July 2019 (GV.NRW.P.377) – and in accordance with § 1 (1) of the General Examination Regulations for Bachelor's and Master's courses at the South Westphalia University of Applied Sciences, the Faculty of Electrical Engineering of the South Westphalia University has issued the following regulations:

**Article I**

The Examination Regulations for the degree course Business Administration with Informatics at the South Westphalia University of Applied Sciences, Soest campus dated 8 August 2018 (public announcement "Amtliche Bekanntmachung der Fachhochschule Südwestfalen – Verkündungsblatt der Fachhochschule Südwestfalen" of the South Westphalia University of Applied Sciences – as of 15 August 2018) are amended with the following changes:

1. § 3 (1) is to be worded as follows:

"(1) In addition to the general admission requirements in accordance with § 3 of the General Examination Regulations, applicants must provide proof of their language skills by demonstrating that they have studied English up to qualification level 1 or up to the acquisition of the entrance qualification for universities of applied sciences (Fachhochschulreife) and have passed with at least the grade "Sufficient" or that their knowledge of the English language is certified by a TOEFL test with at least 575 points or 232 points computer-based or 91 points internet-based or an IELTS test with at least the overall grade 6.5 or an examination according to § 2 with an adequate score."

**Article II**

These regulations will come into effect the day after publication. They are published in the public announcement "Amtliche Bekanntmachung der Fachhochschule Südwestfalen – Verkündungsblatt der Fachhochschule Südwestfalen" of the South Westphalia University of Applied Sciences.

They are issued, after review by the Rectorate of the South Westphalia University, upon decision of the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Electrical Engineering, dated 22 January 2020.
