

Brief Instruction - On-Campus Examinations: Distance and Hygiene Regulations

As the person responsible for examinations, you are required to inform the students at the beginning of the examination about the following important points or to ensure that the supervisor takes over the brief instruction:

- Participation in the examination with symptoms of illness is not allowed.
- The form for traceability of contact details is to be put in the box provided in the examination room.
- The distance regulations of at least 1.50 m must be observed on the entire campus (indoor and outdoor areas).
- Lifts may only be entered individually.
- Physical contact (e.g. handshaking / hugs) is to be avoided.
- The mandatory wearing of a mouth-nose cover applies in all public areas of the university.
-During the examination it is not necessary to wear a mouth-nose cover at the assigned seat. It is mandatory to wear the mouth-nose cover during all movements in the room to protect the present persons.
- The examination room is aired during the examination.
- Gatherings of people are to be avoided even after the examination. This applies to the university environment. Please leave the university building after the examination and leave the outside areas of the campus in an ordered manner and with distance.
- Hygiene regulations in times of a pandemic:
Avoid touching your face if possible, cough and sneeze only in the crook of your arm or a tissue, which must then be disposed of in the waste. Regular and thorough hand washing is also important in times of a pandemic.
